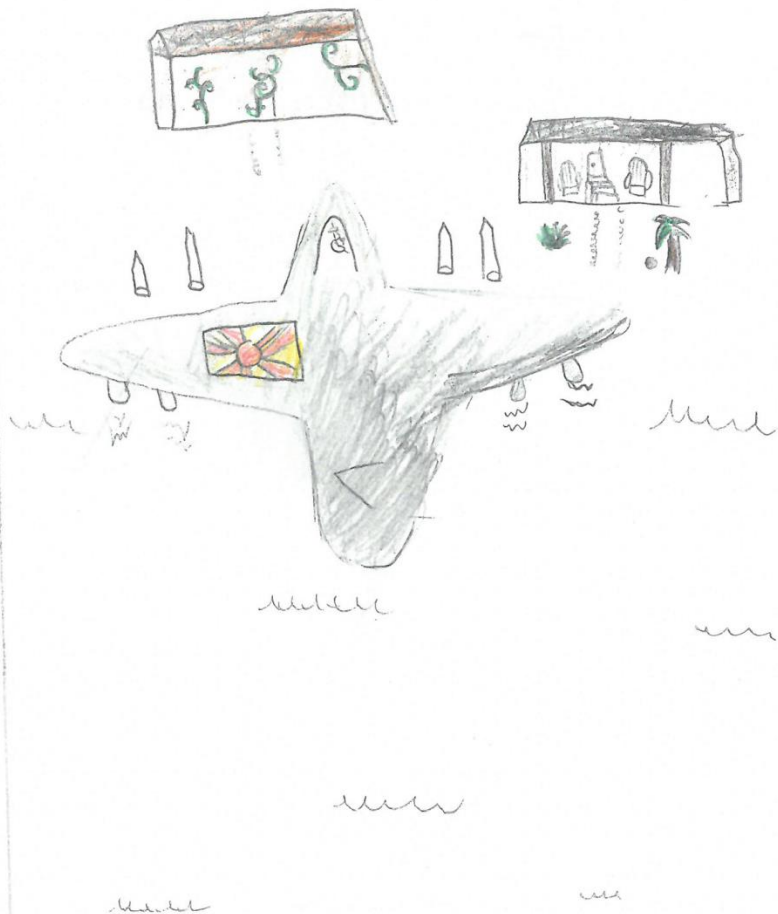

end

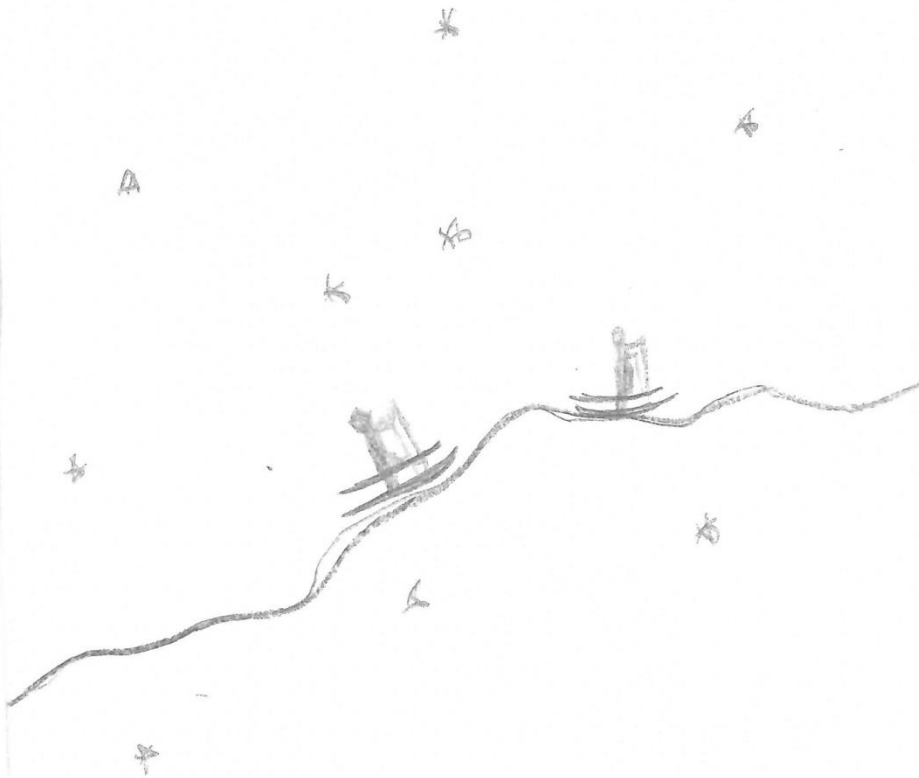
We go to battle. The 1st Mountain
