

Graduation Requirements
LCCHS Interim HS Graduation Requirements for the
classes of 2021, 2022, 2023

In the spring of 2020, Lake County High School – along with the broader Lake County Community – made revisions to the graduation requirements in line with the Colorado State Board of Education guidelines. The decision was made to fully adopt those requirements for all subsequent graduating classes beginning with the class of 2021. However, considering staffing, course offerings, logistics of implementation, and fairness to students, the following exceptions and pathways are in effect for the classes of 2021, 2022 and 2023:

Class of 2021

Will need 24 credits to graduate and will need to have at least one semester in which they participate in an extracurricular activity. 10 of their community service hours must be aligned to their ICAP

Class of 2022

Will need 26 credits to graduate and will need to have at least two semesters in which they participate in an extracurricular activity. 20 of their community service hours must be aligned to their ICAP

Class of 2023

Will need 26 credits to graduate and will need to have at least three semesters in which they participate in an extracurricular activity. 30 of their community service hours must be aligned to their ICAP

These new requirements replace the 24 credit requirement with 26 credits and an Individual Career Academic Plan, that must be approved by a teacher, parents and an administrator. Also, students now must have community service aligned to their ICAP and participate in an extracurricular activity 4/8 semesters.

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
